A TYPICAL DAY ON OUR FRENCH ADVENTURE

Wake up at Harald's and have a leisurely breakfast, analyze tanks, and prepare for the dives. Tanks and gear are loaded into Vince's van, and divers will follow to the day's dive site in their own vehicles.

Vince will conduct an orientation and site briefing at the dive site. Water temperatures are typically around 12 °C, and depths average between 6m and 40m. With these conditions, it's best to aim for one good dive a day. Divers who are stage and/or deco-certified will have the option for longer dive times and technical profiles.

After the dives, teams will enjoy a picnic at the site to refuel before heading off on a visit to one of the many cultural highlights of the area.

Dinner is homemade by Harald and provided as part of the lodging and meal service.
